

The **HERITAGE STANDING (HSI) INTERNSHIP PROGRAM** aims to train emerging professionals wanting to become successful conservation-based structural engineers by providing:

instruction in running a small business

The three-year program has been designed to provide the intern with the experience required to jumpstart their professional career in conservation engineering, either as part of a team or by creating their own specialized firm.

Work and study have been designed for career development. Approximately 80% of the time, the intern will be integrated into the HSI team, gaining experience in: assessment, evaluation, and design for existing buildings, construction support, project management, client communications, and team leadership. The remaining 20% will be spent on formal education, including training sessions and seminars. At the end of the internship, we will help the intern progress to their next career goal.

This is a paid internship with benefits.

Candidates must:

- Have completed a BEng or BScEng with a focus on structural engineering
- Have completed formal training in conservation, with a preference for a MEng or similar applied to building conservation
- Be eligible to work in Canada
